Nature of support 2016-17

- External support from Chipping Norton partnership (Rachel Sellars) providing PE knowledge and expertise for one afternoon every week, working alongside teachers planning, leading, observing and supporting
- Specialist Cricket Coaches to run cricket sessions for all KS2 classes
- Additional TA support (Ruth Henderson) for every PE lesson (10 hours altogether), providing PE expertise for all PE lessons across the school, as well as supporting of tournaments/partnership activities
- Training for staff through CNPS and other sources (Oxfordshire Cricket Board)
- Subsidising fees for pupils to attend extra-curricular clubs/sports tournaments and festivals
- Participation in competitive school sports within the CNPS

Measuring the impact of PE grant spending

We also measure it through annual pupil and parent questionnaires.
